Hi Luke,

Thank you for your email and cooperation in this matter, we will require details of members who have attended the boat club since Thursday the 5th of August 2021, more specifically members who are from areas where the lockdown has been enforced since the 5th of August..

The reason for this is to make sure that both the members of the boat club and also the business are complying with the Chief Health Officers directions in relation to the recent lockdowns.

As a business you have an obligation under OH&S to protect boat club workers and also the members of the boat club that are currently residing on their house boats and you are also bound by the directions of the CHO.

As a business you are responsible for anyone who attends the boat club and you have the responsibility of making sure that any of your members from areas that are currently in lockdown are aware and informed that they are not to attend the boat club during the lockdown period.

The only time they should be allowed to attend is for one of the five reasons travel is allowed if they are applicable or have an exemption, otherwise they should not be allowed entry to the club. (please refer to attached, specifically Part 2 – STAY AT HOME)

If the directions of the Chief Health Officer (please refer to attached) are breached there are hefty fines for both members of the public and also the business itself.

Please make sure your members are informed that they are not to attend the boat club if they are from an area that is currently in lockdown.

One way to limit and protect you're business would be to lock the gate to non-regional members. If a member or any other member of the public from an area that is currently in lockdown attend the boat club they should be refused entry and asked to leave, if they refuse call police.
